

Eastern Pacific Shipping

Investing in the right assets at the right time is a rare skill. Doing it at scale when the rest of the market is still nervously considering its options requires discipline, deep pockets and experience that few can genuinely claim to have.

Eastern Pacific emerged as the first tonnage provider to invest in Dual-Fuel LNG technology at scale during 2019, but that was just part of a much wider commitment to green shipping and technology that saw our judging panel unanimously declare this company the stand-out winner against a field of impressive entries this year.
